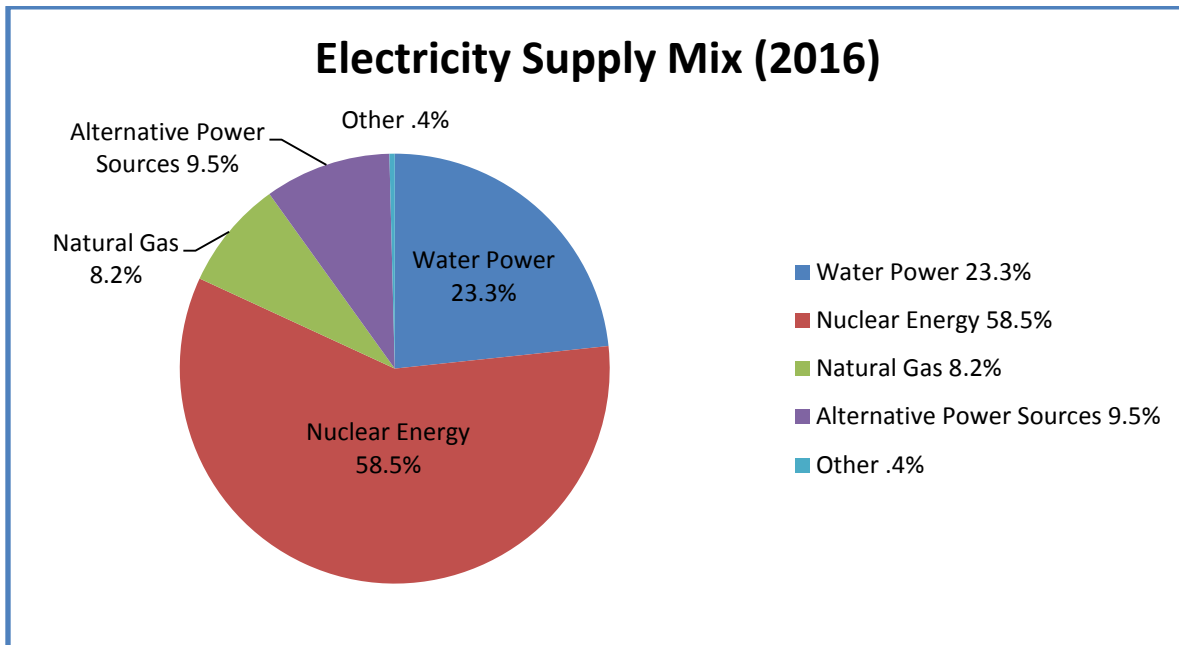


Ontario’s System-Wide Electricity Supply Mix: 2016 Data

PUC Distribution Inc. is obligated, as a distributor of electricity, to supply electricity to every person connected to our distribution system (The Electricity Act 1998). As a provider of Standard Supply Service we are required to disclose the system-wide Electricity Supply Mix.

Under O. Reg. 416/99 the Ministry of Energy is responsible for providing Ontario’s electricity supply mix data for electricity suppliers. The pie chart and table below shows the system-wide electricity supply mix data for 2016. This data must be used by electricity suppliers for the purposes of complying with the disclosure obligations of O. Reg. 416/99 and the Directive. This data should be considered current until further notice.

** Includes dual-fuelled facilities that are predominantly natural gas (e.g., Lennox Generating Station)
